ORDINANCE NO. 10136, S-73

ORDINANCE
REQUIRING BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS IN QUEZON CITY TO
PROVIDE TRASH CANS AND TO MAINTAIN THE CLEANLINESS
AND BEAUTY OF THEIR FRONT YARD, INCLUDING THE STREET
AND BEAUTY OF THEIR FRONT YARD, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATION THEREOF.

Introduced by Councilor E. G. Alinea, Jr. Sponsored by Councilors P. Perlas, Sarino, Roces, Castelo, dela Cruz, Gonzales, Paculdo, Alinea, Jr., Montenegro, J. Perlas, David, Francisco (Fred Montilla), Vera-Perez.

WHEREAS, the present efforts for cleanliness and beautification as one of the goals of the New Society, is the responsibility of all the citizenry who must get involve in the worthy undertaking; Now THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Business establishment in Quezon City are hereby required to provide trash can which shall not be more than one foot in diameter and not more not be more than one foot in diameter and not more than two feet in depth. The trash can shall be painted with the color of the District with a 6-inch white with the color of the middle and extending around the horizontal line at the middle and extending around the trash can. On the white line shall be inscribed in told prints "TRASH CAN" and also indication as to the area number, the barrio or barangay within which the business establishment concerned is located.

shall, at all times, maintain the cleanliness and beauty of their front yards including the street drainage and sidewalk in front of their business establishment.

SEC. 3. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Pesos (\$\frac{1}{2}00.00\$) or imprisonment of not exceeding six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court, the penalty to include the cancellation of business permits.

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If the violation is committed by a corporation or partnership or by any juridical entity, the President or the managing director or partner of the firm shall be held criminally responsible therefor.

Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
