FROHIBITING THE DRINKING OF INTOXICATING LIQOUR OR
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, BEER, AND WINE IN ANY PUBLIC SIDEWALK, STREET, AVENUE, THOROUGHFARE, FARK, OR PLAZA,
AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Introduced by the Committee on Public Safety

## Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City session assembled:

Section 1. The drinking of intoxicating liquur or alcoholic beverages, beer, and wine in any public side-walk, street, avenue, thoroughfare, park, or plaza, at any time of the day or night is hereby prohibited

- Sec. 2. The prohibition mentioned in Section 1 hereof shall not apply to public parks or places designated for picnics, excursions or health resorts and private health resorts or parks duly licensed as such.
- Sec. 3. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Pesos (125.00) nor more than One Hundred Pesos (100.00), or imprisonment of not less than ten (10) days but not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.
- Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on its approval.

AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Introduced by the Committee on Public Safety

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City session assembled:

Section 1. The drinking of intoxicating liquur or alcoholic beverages, beer, and wine in any public side-walk, street, avenue, thoroughfare, park, or plaza, at any time of the day or night is hereby prohibited

Sec. 2. The prohibition mentioned in Section 1 hereof shall not apply to public parks or places designated for picnics, excursions or health resorts and private health resorts or parks duly licensed as such.

Sec. 3. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Pesos (125.00) nor more than One Hundred Pesos (100.00), or imprisonment of not less than ten (10) days but not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on its approval.
