Encl ORDINANCE Numbered 86 / S.47

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRED ORGANIZERS OF PUBLIC MEETINGS, DEMONSTRATIONS OR PARADES FOR ANY PURPOSE TO SECURE PERMIT FROM THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR AT LEAST TWO DAYS BEFORE THE HOLDING OF THE SAME.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City, that:

SEC. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to organize and hold public meetings, (except in private premises) demonstrations or parades for any purpose without securing a written permit from the Office of the City Mayor at least 2 days before the holding of the same.

SEC. 2. All applications for permit to hold such meetings demonstrations or parades shall include the name or names of the organizer or organizers, the object or objects of such meetings or demonstrations and a statement that he or they shall be held, singly or severally, responsible for disturbances of peace and order or for any act or acts contrary to existing laws or ordinance that may occur in connection with the demonstration or meeting.

SEC. 3. Violation of the provisions of the Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less ₱100.00 nor more than ₱200.00 or by imprisonment of not less than 20 days nor more than two months or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
