ORDINANCE Numbered 69

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 AND SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NUMBERED 89 SERIES OF 1941, FIXING THE LICENSE FEE OF BICYCLES WHICH ARE OWNED, KEPT OR USED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 89, series of 1941, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 3. For every license issued under the provisions of the last preceding section, the sum of five pesos (\$\frac{x}{2}\$.00) per annum shall be collected and the corresponding certificate issued together with a plate number which shall be placed or displayed on the rear portion of the bicycle exposed to public view."

SEC. 2. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 89, series of 1941 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 5. Any person who shall knowingly or will-fully refuse to secure a license for any bicycle under his possession or control within the limits of Quezon City shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten pesos (\$10.00) nor more than twenty-five pesos (\$25.00), or by imprisonment of not less than four (4) days nor more than ten (10) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court."

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
