

Crisologo joins QC mayoral race

Quezon City First District Rep. Vincent “Bingbong” Crisologo on Monday filed his Certificate of Candidacy (CoC) for mayor at the Commission on Elections (Comelec) office in Quezon City on Monday.

Crisologo will run with TV host and former barangay counselor lawyer John Peter “Jopet” Sison under the Partido Demokratiko Pilipino-Lakas ng Bayan.

They will be facing QC Vice Mayor [Joy Belmonte](#) and her running mate District 3 Councilor [Gian Sotto](#) and former congressman Chuck Mathay and running mate Councilor [Roderick Paulate](#).

Crisologo and Sison vowed to provide more social services for Quezon City residents.

“People here in Quezon City are being shortchanged. There are very few or no social services at all. In my district, I can aid this as congressman, but I do not think the other districts can do that,” Crisologo told reporters.

He added that people should elect a mayor who knows when to suspend classes.

“The next mayor of Quezon City should be a person who can quickly decide on class suspensions,” Crisologo said.

In April, Crisologo trailed Belmonte in a pre-election survey conducted by online election watchdog Election Watch PH 2019.
