Ordinance No. SP-755, S-1999

AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) MONTHS THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-651, S-98, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS, OPERATORS, LESSEES, OCCUPANTS AND CONCESSIONARIES OF BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, CONTRACTORS AND DEVELOPERS AND PERSONS REQUIRED TO SECURED BUSINESS AND/OR BUILDING PERMITS IN DOING BUSINESS OR UNDER-TAKING CONSTRUCTION OR REPAIR WORK IN QUEZON CITY TO SECURE PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE, PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE" FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVIEW.

WHEREAS, the implementation of ordinance No. SP-651,S-98, requiring business establishments to secure Public Liability Insurance is causing financial burden for most business operator;

WHEREAS, numerous complaints have been aired since the implementation of the said ordinance;

WHEREAS, there is a need for review of the ordinance to make it more attuned to the on going economic crisis of our country and so as not to further hamper the growth of our business community;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED

SECTION 1. The implementation of ordinance No. SP-651, S-98, is hereby suspended for a period of three (3) months for the purpose of review.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
