ORDINANCE NO. SP. HTO -S.99

PASS IN ALL PROPOSED SHOPPING MALLS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, due to rapid development and increasing economic activities, are numerous shopping mails proposed to be constructed in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, everyday, a particular shopping mall attracts thousands of people thing to vehicular traffic congestion particularly in entrances and/or exit areas due beavy pedestrian movement;

WHEREAS, in order to address such traffic congestion, there is a need to muside for the construction of pedestrian overpass that will lessen pedestrian new ement thereby resulting to a smooth vehicular flow;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN ESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. No Building Permit shall be issued by the City Building Official the construction of shopping malls in Quezon City unless the construction plan bereof carries with it a design for pedestrian overpass connected to the building of the hopping mall.

SECTION 2. The design and location of the podestrian overpass shall be mbject to the approval of the DPWH-QC Engineering District and Metropolitan inila Development Authority (MMDA).

SECTION 3. The pedestrian overpass required under Section 1 hereof shall be constructed simultaneously with the construction of the shopping mail at the expense of the owner thereof. Upon completion, the owner shall immediately transfer/turnment the same or any portion thereof particularly that portion located on the expense of public Works and Highways (DPWH).





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SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
