

ORDINANCE NO. SP- **1225**, s-2903

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING COMPUTER TRAINING TO ALL QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES, APPROPRIATING FUNDS NECESSARY THEREFOR TO BE TAKEN FROM THE FUND ALLOCATION PROVIDED FOR IN THE TASK FORCE QUEZON CITY INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY.

WHEREAS, despite the development in the field of Information Technology, there still is a great number of Quezon City government employees who are not familiar with the use of the computer;

WHEREAS, through the proper education and instruction in the proper and effective use of the computer, it is expected that the performance of all employees of the city will improve dramatically, to the ultimate advantage of the people we wish to serve;

WHEREAS, there is a need to spearhead a training program for all Quezon City government employees in the proper use of the computer in the workplace;

WHEREAS, the City Council, as a body, desires a more competent workforce, one that is versed and familiar with the use of computers.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN
SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. - This ordinance shall be known and cited as,
The Computer Training Program for the Quezon City Government Employees
Ordinance.

SECTION 2. PRESCRIBED ACTS. - The Task Force Quezon City
Information Technology (TFQCIT) under the Office of the Mayor is hereby
charged and authorized to conduct the training of all Quezon City government
employees in the proper and effective use of computers.

SECTION 3. COVERAGE. - All Quezon City government employees
including contractual and casual who are holding clerical, technical supervisory and
executive positions of all ranks and levels are encouraged to undergo a training
program in basic computer science and technology.

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTING RULES. - The TFQCIT is hereby
authorized to formulate the necessary rules and guidelines for holding and
conducting computer training for all Quezon City government employees who wish
to avail of the training program. The rules and guidelines so formulated by the task
force may provide that an officer or employee already versed with the use of the
computer shall be exempt from the computer training program provided herein.

SECTION 5. ALLOCATION. - The funds necessary therefor shall be taken
from the fund allocation provided for in the Task Force Quezon City Information
Technology.


SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any provision or part hereof is
held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the ordinance or the provision not
otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE - All provisions of laws, orders,
decree, including rules and regulations and local legislative measures inconsistent
herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.






