



THE QUEZON CITY CONSULTATIVE COUNCIL



The Quezon City Consultative Council was created by virtue of Executive Order No. 14 issued on July 7, 1987 by Mayor Brigido R. Simon, Jr. The Mayor was prompted to issue the Order due to the following reasons:

- The rising expectations of the people, particularly the city employees, for their economic and social
 upliftment necessitated regular consultations with employees' representatives;
- The upsurge of rallies and protest actions against the city administration needed a consultative body in which complaints and grievances of city government employees' could be resolved in a peaceful manner.

The Quezon City Consultative Council was organized with the help of Mr. Rolando P. Montiel, then Sr. Executive Assistant to the Mayor and Officer-In-Charge of the General Services Office.

Any employee who holds a permanent, temporary, casual or contractual appointment is eligible for membership in the Council provided he is below the level of Assistant Department or Office Head and has served the Quezon City Government continuously for at least one (1) year.

Each department or office is entitled to one representative for every one hundred employees; however, an office with less than one hundred employees shall be entitled to one (1) representative. The representative shall be chosen by the employees of the department or office themselves either by (a) viva voce (b) secret balloting, or (c) a resolution.


The Council has the following duties and functions:

- Conduct monthly dialogs with the City Mayor to discuss issues affecting the employees' legitimate and collective interests and aspirations within a democratic framework;
- Formulate rules and regulations on mass protests carried within the Quezon City Hall building and premises;
- Recommend to the Mayor measures/policies that will enhance employer-employee relationship;
- Render periodic reports and submit recommendations to the City Mayor for evaluation and/or implementations;
- 5. Create standing committee that may be necessary in the pursuit of its functions and duties.



On September 2 to 5, 1987 some 70 members of the Consultative Council representing 7,000 employees of the City Agency held a three-day live-in working conference at the Makiling Country Resort in Calamba, Laguna,

In the conference it was agreed that the members will limit their functions and purposes to what is enunciated in the Executive Order No. 14 creating the Council.



Mayor Brigido R. Simon, Jr. in his inspirational talk, stressed that the Council is aimed at providing an effective mechanism or conduct between employees and the government. He also asked the members to wear "two hats", one as an employee and the other as a Quezon City resident.

He also emphasized that the main rationale of the Council is to provide an effective voice or mechanism for what may be termed as "employees power". He said that the employees need not express their grievances in the streets or in public places but in the sobriety of a conference table.

During the conference, participants were oriented on how the city government operates and their corresponding roles. They also discussed new and existing government laws for their guidance and information. Participants were also taught how to select, program and properly implement activities for efficient public services

Cognizant of its role as the employees' representative body, the QCCC spearheaded laudable projects such as the raffling off of some 471 lots located at the Quezon City General Hospital Compound to QC Government Employees (see related story on page 15). Another project was a performance audit conducted to assess whether an employee is competent, dedicated, corrupt, etc. The employees responded favorably and candidly answered the survey questionaires which subsequently determined and helped solve some of their problems and grievances.

The early approval of the Ordinance granting additional cost of living allowance introduced by Councilors Herrera and Galarpe was also influenced on strong rep: **.entations made by the QCCC.

Financial assistance in the amount of One Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\$1,000.00) for every fire victim and Two Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\$2,000.00) for each deceased employee as death benefit were also extended. This assistance came from QCCC's pet project — the Quezon City Welfare Foundation. The seed money for this Foundation was raised by the "1988 Pa-Raffle".

Meanwhile, the QCCC continously plans and draw up policies and programs geared toward enhancing the welfare of the City government's employees,

On the occasion of the QC Golden Jubilee it has been tasked with a wider responsibility including the putting up of the QCCC Gintong Parangal Souvenir Program. The "Gintong Parangal" event entails other duties among which are: the preparations for testimonial dinner as a fitting culmination of the anniversary rites and the honoring of Quezon City's prominent leaders in the last 50 years highlighting the nights affair. The legwork and research, indeed, contributed to the success of the Capital City's Golden Jubilee Celebration.

QUEZON CITY EMPLOYEES HOUSING PROJECT

Never has there been a time when a housing project intended for the benefits of Quezon City Hall employees come to reality as that of the present. Yet, it has always been a sincere desire by the city government to provide affordable housing projects not only for our homeless co-workers but also for our urban poor residents. Several plans, programs and other studies for low-cost mass housing project have been conceived but none ever came to clu fruition.

However, the assumption of Mayor Brigido R. Simon, Jr. as Officer-In-Charge of Quezon City in 1986 brought new hope among the homeless Quezon City residents like us. He immediately formed a technical staff to prepare a low cost social housing program for the city's homeless constituents.

Presently, the city government has three housing projects. One is the Barangay Manresa on-site Development Project which is undergoing construction. Another one, the biggest, is the Quezon City Social Housing Program in Payatas. The third one intended for both the City Hall employees and other Quezon City residents is the one located at the Quezon City General Hospital Compound. Several other housing projects have been proposed but rejected due to unaffordable prices and remote location. The city government has identified 66 Areas of priority development (APD).

The chosen site for employees housing project is the third one. This property with a total area of 77,548. square meters was purchased several years ago from the Colegio de San Jose Seminary on October 1986, Mayor Brigido R. Simon, Jr. assigned the newly elected members of Quezon City Consultative Council thru its Chairman, Mr. Isidro Manikis, to undertake the distribution of housing unit by raffle. A Housing Project Committee within the council was created designating Mr. Cecil T. Lim, a QCCC representative of the City Budget Office as its head.

A study was conducted on affordability cost, loanability of employess and salary statistics. National Home Mortgage Loan requirements, financing for construction, ocular investigation of the housing site and others, although not necessarily a part of their assignment, was also incorporated in the study. A final report was then submitted to the QCCC body including the raffle program containing among others the minimum qualification requirement. Deliberations were conducted during the regular and special meeting for the final approval of the various plans and program for the raffle. However, due to time constraint, the council agreed to recommend to the City Mayor the immediate holding of the raffle before the end of 1986 without waiting for the actual construction of the housing units. Notices for application in the housing program were circulated. The limited housing/ lot units were distributed by quota system to the different offices/department proportionate to the total member of their permanent personnel. The raffle was finally conducted by the QCCC at City Hall lobby on Dec. 16, 1988 wherein the lucky winners were immediately handed their certificates.

A subsequent committee on housing was again created by the City Mayor which were composed of Mr. Isidro Manikis as chairman, Arch. Gerardo G. Magat as Vice-Chairman and Atty. Christian Valencia, Engr. Patricio Senador and Violeta C. Portillo as members. They were tasked to coordinate and implement this project. Among their accomplishment were the reconstitution of the title of the land, review of pricing, coordination with contractor, review of housing plan, coordination with the city council and others.

With the unwaivering support of the Quezon City council, a resolution was passed on November 10, 1988 formally apporving the establishment of Quezon City Hall Housing Project, Another resolution was subsequently passed authorizing the City Mayor to negotiate for the construction of low-cost socialized housing project at Bgy. Bahay Toro, strategically located at the heart of the city. It is near the popular SM shopping center, several government agencies, schools, markets, parks and other social conveniences. The place is relatively more elevated than its surrounding areas making it flood-free. It has three exit roads, that lead to EDSA and to Congressional Ave.

Market value of lots in the area range from P1, 500 to P2,000 per sq. m. However, thru the City Mayor's intercession prices of lots for socialized housing will be subsidized by the city government for wider affordability. It shall be payable by installment thru the National Home Mortgage and Financing. This housing project is estimated to accommodate around 3,000 families.

There are two types of housing units being considered. The first type is a four-storey condominium building. Each unit will have an approximate floor area of 38 to 44 square meters open for sale to any qualified Quezon City resident. The other is the so-called Socialized Housing Project type costing around P80,000 per unit. It is intended for the Quezon City Hall employees who won the raffle and also for the actual occupants of the area. Each unit will have an estimated area of 32 sq. m. Unlike, the common type row-houses, around eight units are artistically clustered forming a compound. At the center is an access lane between front lawns also designed to serve as a strip that can be lined with trees or ornamental shrubs. Ecological balance and clean surrounding will be given emphasis. Durability and functional design are also given prime attention without sacrificing affordability of future tenants. As invisioned, the area will accorded with basic facilities such as water from MWSS, lighting, eight concrete lanes, social hall, playground and others. For commuting convenience to and from the city hall, a public utility vehicle is being planned to be provided thru the help of the city government. With our meager resources on hand as mere City Hall employees, we expect the city government to continously develop the area. — CECILIO LIM


OUR LADY, QUEEN OF THE HOLY ROSARY

(Patron Saint of Quezon City)

The Blessed Virgin is venerated by the church under different titles or aspects of her role in the salvation of mankind worked out by Jesus Christ, Our Lord. Under the title of Queen of the Holy Rosary, she showed in many occasions her special love and protection for the Philippines. Since the Spanish times, she has showered favours to individuals as well as to the whole nation, because they have been faithful to the recitation of her rosary.

The almost four-century old image of the Blessed Virgin of the Holy Rosary, venerated in Sto. Domingo Church, Quezon City, is the

center of the nationwide celebration of the "FEAST OF LA NAVAL." This feast, with its colorful novena and procession, was initiated because of the vow made by the beleagered Armed Forces of the Philippines, mainly the naval forces, in so many battles with pirates, Chinese, English and Dutch who wanted to invade and occupy the Philippines. Notwithstanding the superiority in arms and numbers, these invaders were repulsed from our shores, more on the efficiency of fervent prayer than on the out-moded and meager logistics of the country. Thus, this venerable image of the Blessed Virgin came to be called, beside its title of "Queen of the Holy Rosary," the "Virgin of La Naval," the "Capitana," the "Almiranta," the "Patrona."




